

REAA-NB Appraiser Scholarship

2011 Eligibility Requirements:

- 1.) Applicant must already be licensed at the Trainee (AT) level or greater.
- 2.) Applicant must be a member in good standing with REAA-NB.
- 3.) Scholarships are available to all members at every license level for appraisers that may be pursuing a license upgrade or for professional/technical development.
- 4.) Applicant must submit a Scholarship Application package including:
 - a.) Proof of course completion within one-year of application date. (Since 2011 is the first year for awarding a scholarship, exceptions to the one-year completion date will be considered on an individual basis. The one-year rule will be strictly enforced for scholarships awarded after 2011).
 - b.) Provide a full catalog description of the course taken attached to the application. Proof of completion is required.
 - c.) Submit a one-page written essay - "Why I Need a REAA-NB Scholarship?"
 - d.) Deadline to submit the application will be by October 1st for November 2011 award.
- 5.) All USPAP courses are ineligible. Live courses only, 8 or more classroom hours required. Course must have application to real estate appraisal.
- 6.) There will be a maximum of two (2) scholarship awards per calendar year. (2011 may require more than two scholarships).
- 7.) Selection of each scholarship award recipient(s) by consensus of the Education Committee.
- 8.) Applicants will be limited to one (1) scholarship award per calendar year.
- 9.) Award amount(s) of each scholarship will be determined by the Education Committee regarding to the number of awards per calendar year and monies available within the **REAA-NB Scholarship Fund**.
